



Update on Advisory

As covered in a prior advisory yesterday, [seen here](#), the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) recently announced its intent to use two loan necessity questionnaires with respect to the loan forgiveness application process under the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP). For clarification, the forms included in our advisory have not formally been issued by the SBA, but instead have been made available for review. The SBA is soliciting public comments on these forms, and it is possible that the final version(s) may change. Comments are being solicited until November 25, 2020, and we intend to cover any material changes in the final form(s) with a supplemental alert, if applicable.
